

Bugs 'R' Us

Define a new site and an images folder. Also create a folder called 'original_images'.

Create a new blank page (give it any name you like).

With the page open go into Code View and add the following code (make sure that Dreamweaver doesn't close the <div> tags in the wrong place).

<div id="wrapper">  
  
    <div id="logo"></div>  
  
    <div id="content">  
  
        <div id="navigation"></div>  
  
        <div id="info"></div>  
  
    </div>  
  
    <div id="footer"></div>  
  
</div>
```

Now all you need to do is create the style sheet.


Open the CSS Styles panel and then click the New CSS Rule icon

Select Tag and type body into the box

Make sure it is set to New Style Sheet File and click OK

Save the style sheet

In Type enter the following:



Type

Font: Verdana, Arial, Helvetica, sans-serif

Size: 12 pixels Weight:

Style: Variant:

Line height: 20 pixels Case:

Decoration: underline overline line-through blink none

Color: #666666

Go to Box and set both the Margins and Padding to: 0

In Block set Text Align to: Left

Click OK.

New CSS Rule icon

Select Advanced and enter: #wrapper

Go to Box and set the Width to: 770px and Height to: auto

New CSS Rule icon

Select Advanced and enter: #logo

In Box set the Width to: 770px and the Height to: 140px

New CSS Rule icon

Select Advanced and enter: #content

In Box set Width to: 770px and Height to: auto

New CSS Rule icon

Select Advanced and enter: #navigation

In Box set Width to: 150px and Height to: auto, set Float to: Left

New CSS Rule icon

Select Advanced and enter: #info

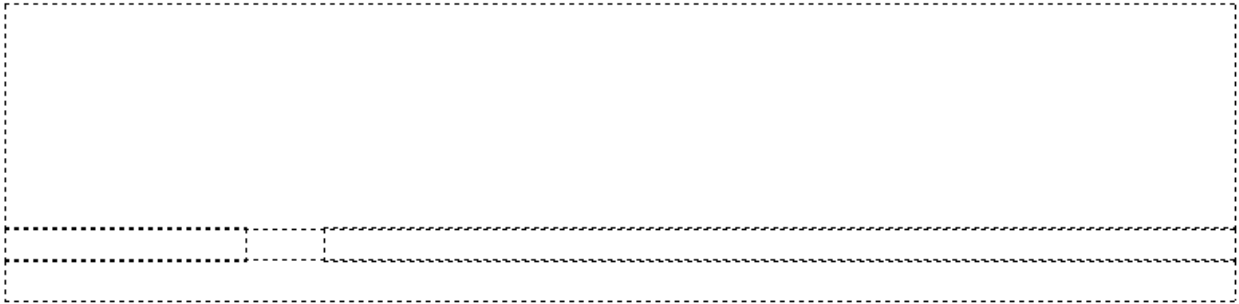
Go to Box and set the Width to: 570px and the Height to: auto, set Float to: Right

New CSS Rule icon

Select Advanced and enter: #footer

Go to Box and set Width to: 770px and Height to: 25px, set Clear to: Both

Your page should now look like this:



Now for some content!

Click in #navigation and enter the following (you will have to go into Code View later and take the spaces out):

home reptiles arachnids insects facts contact

Then turn each one into a link. Once you have done that go into Code View and remove the spaces between the links.

```
ef="#">home</a> <a href="#">repti:

```

>: the space is denoted here by the grey box between and <a href :<

Click at the top of the #info div and enter: Welcome to Bugs 'R' Us, change to Heading 1

Copy the lorem ipsum text from the web site and paste it under the heading

Under that enter: Fact or Fiction?, change to Heading 2

Copy the lorem ipsum text from the web site and paste it under the heading

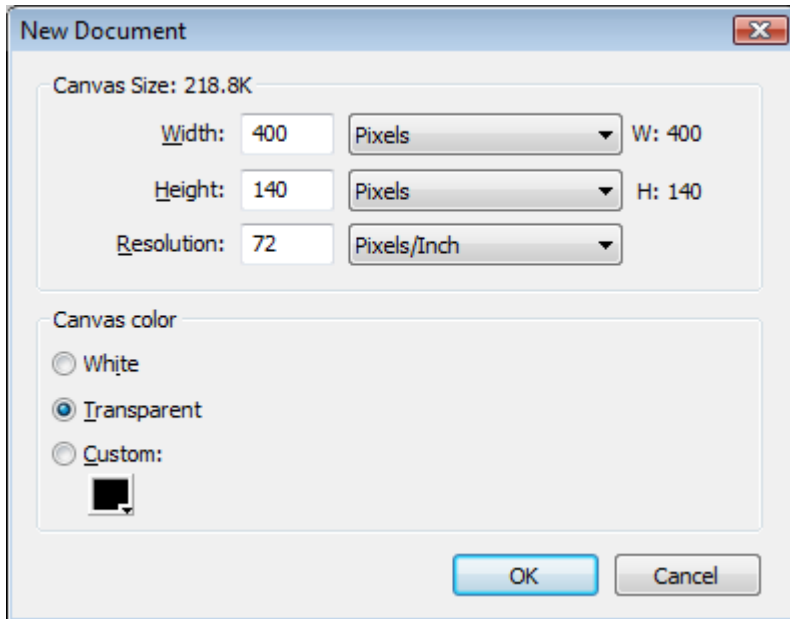
Under that enter: What Next?, change to Heading 2

Copy the lorem ipsum text from the web site and paste it under the heading

Now for one of the graphics files you will need.

Load Fireworks

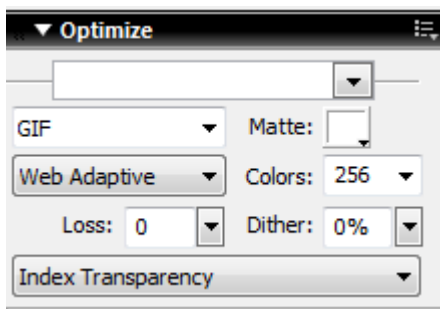
Create a new blank canvas with the following settings (make sure that Transparent is selected):



Click OK

Select the Text tool and enter: Bugs 'R' Us, choose your own font/colour/size combo (the example is Mistral, 80)

Now go over to the Optimize panel and add the following settings (you will need to do this to make the background of the image transparent):



When the image is to your liking Export it to your images folder, call it logo (don't forget to also save the file as a .png into your original_images folder)

Leave Fireworks open for the time being, we'll get back it later.

Back in Dreamweaver drag the logo image into the #logo div. Add appropriate Alt text.

Now to style the <h1> and <h2> tags.

Over to your CSS panel and click on the New CSS Style icon

Change the selector to Tag and add: h1

Change the font size to: 14

Go to Block and set Letter Spacing to: 0.25ems

Then go to Box and set the Bottom Margin to: 5

Click OK

Go over to your style list

Right-click h1 and select Duplicate

Name it h2

Now for a paragraph style

New CSS Rule icon

Change selector to Tag and add: p

In Block set Text Align to: justify

In Box set Padding to: 5 and Top Margin to: 0

Now for the links

Click the New CSS Rule icon

Change the selector to Advanced and add the following:

`#navigation a, #navigation a:link, #navigation a:visited`

In Type set Decoration to: none and Line Height: 25

In Block set Text align to: left and Display to: block

In Box set Width to: 145 and Height to: 25, set Float to: left

Set the Left Padding to: 5

Go to Border and set a Bottom Border, dashed, 1 and #666666

Go back to Type and set the font colour to: #666666

Now for the hover state

Go over to your style list and duplicate the style you just created, name it: `#navigation a:hover`

once you have duplicated it right-click the new style and change the text colour

Save and view the page.

Images

For this you will need to download the images from the example page. Save them straight into your images folder. The background image can be downloaded via the link on the page.

The background image needs to be added to the <body> tag. Go over to your style lilt and double-click the body style

Go to Background and click the Browse button

Locate the file you need (spider.jpg)

Set Repeat to: Repeat and Attachment to: Scroll

Click OK

Now double-click the #wrapper div

Go to box and set the Left and Right margins to: auto

Go to Border and set the border to solid, 5, #CAD287

Drag tarantula.jpg onto the page

Click the New CSS Rule icon

Change it to Class and enter: .tarantula

Go to Box and enter: 300, 300 and Float Right

OK

With image selected click next to Class and select tarantula

Drag lizard.jpg onto the page

Click the New CSS Rule icon

Change it to Class and enter: .lizard

Go to Box and enter: 200, 200 and Float Right

OK

With image selected click next to Class and select snake

Double-click h1

Go to Border

Set a Bottom border: dashed, 1, #CAD287

Repeat with the h2 style

Save and view.
